

Monroe-Chester Sportsmen's Club 2018 Rimfire Pistol & Rifle Steel Plate Match



Date:

• Sunday 5/20/2018

This match is intended to be "ammunition friendly" in these times of tight supply. As a result, it has a low round count (minimum of 24 rounds). The match will be fun and will accommodate any and all shooters from ages 12 to senior. We want everybody to be able to shoot, and the course of fire reflects this. The matches will be open to the general public.

Rimfire Steel match will be held on the outdoor pistol range.

Match will start with a shooter's meeting and safety briefing at 9:30 AM.

The first relay will commence at 10:00 AM. The final relay will run at 2:00 PM.

During the match the range **<u>will not</u> remain open** for shooters not competing in the match.

Firearm:

Any safe, legal, rimfire, .22LR caliber, bolt-action, lever-action, pump-action or semi-auto rifle may be used.

Any safe, legal, rimfire, .22LR caliber pistol or revolver may be used.

All firearms used will be compliant with the NY SAFE act, and as such magazines with a capacity greater than 10 rounds may **not** be used in this competition.

Divisions:

The matches will be divided into the following divisions:

- 1. Semi-Auto Rifle, Iron Sight
- 2. Semi-Auto Rifle, Optical Sight
- 3. Lever/Pump/Bolt-Action Rifle, Iron Sight
- 4. Lever/Pump/Bolt-Action Rifle, Optical Sight
- 5. Pistol/Revolver, Iron Sight
- 6. Pistol/Revolver, Optical Sight

Course of Fire:

The match will consist of four strings, each consisting of an array of targets, at varying distances, each string timed separately. The competitor will start at a low-ready position with 10 rounds loaded under command of the Range Officer. At the sound of the start signal the competitor will knock down as many targets as he can, shooting no more than 10 rounds.

Rules:

Start position is behind the table with the muzzle touching the table.

No part of the rifle may touch the ground in prone position.

Bipods are not permitted.

Shooters will assume seated or prone positions on the clock (i.e. after the start signal is given), with exemptions for shooters with physical disabilities or injuries, at the discretion of the RO. Shooters will load only under command of the match RO.

Scoring:

The shooter's score for each string is the time plus 20 seconds for each target not hit plus any penalties. Shooters may fire as many relays as they want to at each match, within the time constraints of the match.

Shooters will be notified of their scores & standings via the Monroe-Chester Sportsmens Club website.

Prizes:

The final score for the match will be the best score submitted for each shooter for each division. Prizes will be awarded in the following divisions:

- 7. Semi-Auto Rifle, Iron Sight
- 8. Semi-Auto Rifle, Optical Sight
- 9. Lever/Pump/Bolt-Action Rifle, Iron Sight
- 10. Lever/Pump/Bolt-Action Rifle, Optical Sight
- 11. Pistol/Revolver, Iron Sight
- 12. Pistol/Revolver, Optical Sight

The Lewis System will be used in the determination of prizes.

A minimum of 3 shooters in each category/division will be required for a prize to be awarded.

Cost:

Each relay will cost \$5.
