

<u>The 2019 Monroe-Chester</u> <u>Bulls-Eye Pistol League</u>

(This Is An <u>Official NRA Registered League</u> and Will Be Fired Under All Current 2019 NRA Rules For Bulls-Eye Competition.)

CLASSIFICATION: All individuals and teams will compete under their NRA Classification. Anyone who does not hold a current NRA Classification will fire this league as an Unclassified Master.

ELIGIBILITY: The league will be open to all club members and each member must show their 2019 club I.D. and club number to participate.

TEAMS: No team will be composed of fewer then four individuals. If more than one team is entered from one club, each will be named or numbered. The four highest scores in each match will be used for team scores.

RULES: All current 2018 NRA Standard Pistol rules will apply. All league competitors will be governed by the League By-Laws.

COURSE OF FIRE: The National Match Gallery Course for 50 feet will be used for both center-fire and rim-fire. The first course will be Slow Fire which will be 10 shots in ten minutes. The second course will be Time Fire which will be 10 shots fired in two strings of 5 rounds in 20 seconds for each string. The third course will be Rapid Fire which will be 10 shots fired in two strings of 5 rounds in 10 seconds for each string.

TARGETS: The B-2 target will be used for all Slow Fire and the B-3 will be used for both Timed and Rapid Fire for both center fire and rim fire. All targets must have the official Monroe-Chester date stamp to qualify for score. All targets must be stapled in order with the score sheets and left in the league folder in the club house. **SCORING:** All scoring will be done after all three courses of fire have been completed. All scores must be totaled and submitted on the official scoring forms supplied in the club house and stapled to the top of the three targets in the sequence that they were fired.

AWARDS: Plaques will be awarded for both Rim-Fire and Center-Fire to individuals and teams for overall First, Second and Third place. If there are more than twenty individual competitors there will also be awards for First, Second and Third place in "B" Class and "C" Class, which will be determined by the Lewis System.

SCHEDULE: The League will start on Monday, January 2, 2019 and continue through Sunday, December 31, 2019. There will be ten total matches for rim-fire and ten total matches for center-fire. Only the five highest scores will be used to compute the aggregate score of both the rim-fire and the center-fire matches.

CHALLENGES: All challenges must be made as soon as the scores are posted on the bulletin board in the club house on the first Friday of each month. Each challenge will be charged at \$5.00 paid to the league secretary.

FEES: There will be a non-refundable \$160.00 donation for all club members and each member must have a current 2018 club ID and number to participate in this league.

NOTE: The Monroe Chester Club requires all participants to have a valid and current NRA membership number when registering for the league.
