2019 Centerfire Rifle Steel Matches



Dates:

- Sunday 5/19/2019
- Sunday 7/21/2019
- Sunday 8/18/2019
- Sunday 9/15/2018

These matches are intended to be “ammunition friendly” in these times of tight supply. As a result they have a low minimum round count (<20 rounds). The matches will be fun and will accommodate any and all shooters from ages 12 to senior. We want everybody to be able to shoot, and the course of fire reflects this. The matches will be open to the general public.

Each match will start with a shooter's meeting and safety briefing at 9:30 AM.

The first relay will commence at 10:00 AM. The final relay will run at 2:00 PM.

During the match the rifle range **will not remain open** for shooters not competing in the match.

The range will be under control of the match Range Officer (RO), for **all** shooters.

Firearm:

Any safe, legal, centerfire, bolt-action or semi-auto rifle may be used.

All semi-auto rifles will be compliant with the NY SAFE act, and as such magazines with a capacity greater than 10 rounds may **not** be used in this competition.

Divisions:

The matches will be divided in to two categories, **Iron Sight** and **Optical Sight**.

The match will be further divided into **Semi-Auto** and **Bolt-Action**

Course of Fire:

The match will have two strings, each timed separately:

String 1:

- Several steel plates will be located at **200 yards**.
- Shooter will fire from behind a fixed barrier.
- On the start signal the shooter will have a maximum of **90 seconds** to hit each target once.

String 2:

- An array of steel targets will be located at **100 yards**.
- Shooting position is freestyle, or from behind a fixed barricade
- Use of the bench is not permitted.
- Shooter will start in the low ready position.
- On the start signal the shooter will have a maximum of **180 seconds** to hit each target once.

If needed, targets will be reset between shooters

Rules:

Starting position is standing with the rifle in the low ready position.

At the sound of the buzzer the shooter will assume his desired firing position and engage the targets, No part of the rifle may touch the ground in prone position.

Bipods are not permitted.

Shooters will assume seated or prone positions on the clock (i.e. after the start signal is given), with exemptions for shooters with physical disabilities or injuries, at the discretion of the RO.

Shooters will load only under command of the match RO.

Scoring:

The shooter's score for each string is the time plus 20 seconds for each target not hit plus any penalties. Shooters may fire as many relays as they want to at each match, within the time constraints of the match.

Shooters will be notified of their scores & standings via the Monroe-Chester Sportsmens Club website.

Prizes:

The final score for the match will be the best score submitted for each shooter for each division.

Prizes will be awarded in the following divisions:

- Semi-Auto, Optic Sight
- Semi-Auto, Iron Sight
- Bolt-Action, Optic Sight
- Bolt-Action, Iron Sight

The Lewis System will be used in the determination of prizes.

A minimum of 3 shooters in each category/division will be required for a prize to be awarded.

Cost:

Each relay will cost \$5.
